


# **About the Verdigre Youth Survey**

The Verdigre youth survey is an online tool to measure perceptions of current Verdigre junior and high school students. They are asked various questions about their impressions of Verdigre, future career plans and interest in remaining or returning to Verdigre. The youth survey was given to all students in grades 7 - 12 at the local high school. A total of 78 youth completed the survey.


### **Interest in Educational Courses**

The youth were first asked what out-of-school education courses would be of interest to them. Many youth are interested in entrepreneurship training and many are also interested in leadership training. Just under one-half (44%) are interested in entrepreneurship training that includes hands-on learning experiences and two in ten (20%) are interested in leadership training for personal growth and community opportunities. Many youth (43%) were interested in other courses. Some suggested courses of interest including: engine mechanics (1), playing sports and being in business (1), shop (1), and trade practice (1).




### **Future Plans**

When all students were asked about their plans after graduation, most youth plan to further their education. Over four in ten (41%) plan to attend a four-year college or university. And, three in ten (30%) plan to go to a two-year trade or technical school or community college. Just over two in ten



(21%) plan to start their own business or work for someone else (26%) and 14 percent don't know their future plans.

When responses from just juniors and seniors are examined, 39% plan to go to a four-year college or university and 31% plan to attend a two-year school. Just over three in ten (31%) plan to start their own business.




# **Community Impressions**

Over one-half of the youth rate Verdigre as either a good (40%) or excellent (14%) place to live.

When asked what they see as Verdigre's strengths, 77 youth responded. The responses included mentions of the following themes:

- Small community (18)
- People (14)
- Friendly (8)
- Helpful or helping others (8)
- Kolach Days (5)
- Cool or fun events (4)



- Welcoming (3)
- Other responses mentioned nothing, sense of community, sports, education, don't know, powerlifting, farming, and the community.

The complete list of responses is included in **Appendix Table 1**.

When asked what amenities they would most like to see added or improved, 77 responses were received. The top response categories included:

- Swimming pool (20)
- added businesses (15)
- roads (9)
- park improvements (8)

- gym or rec center (8)
- sports fields (8)
- walking paths (8)
- track (6)

• golf course (3)

- sidewalks (3)
- Other responses include creek access (2), more things to do (2), new basketball hoops (1), the hall (1), pool league (1), softball team (1), more jobs (1), and Timber Lake (3).


When asked what type of community events they would like to see, 74 responses were received. The top types of events mentioned included:

- unsure (14)
- concerts or dances (12)
- more sport events (8)
- more events in general (6)

- fairs or carnivals (5)
- sand volleyball tournaments (5)
- walks or runs (4)
- community cleanups (3)
- Other responses included: firework shows (1), drive in movie night (1), roller rink (1), another festival (1), turtle races (1), race track (1), bull-a-ramas (1), racing (1), banquets (1), and video games (1).



The youth were next given a list of potential community projects and were asked what priority level they would rate each. Most youth rated cleaning up the community (64.5%), a new community/ activity/wellness center (55%), and a new fire hall (54%) as a high or the highest priority. Four in ten rated downtown beautification (40%) as at least a high priority. Just over one-quarter (26.5%) rated a new swimming pool as at least a high priority. Other items listed include: gym, better parks, bigger campsites, fix the streets, fix the sidewalks, golf course, improving school budget, more businesses, more places for kids and children to go hang out, redo the hall, and roads.




The youth were given a list of items and were asked which they would like to see included in a community center if one were to be built. At least three in ten said they would definitely like to see the following included in the community center: fitness center with equipment (49%), other (47%),

conference/buffet area (36%), and teen lounge center (33%). Some of the other options written in included: a new farm service, apartments, bigger library, entertainment room (with pool, foosball, pingpong), a gun range, pool, restrooms, top notch golf course, and video game area.




### Reasons to Stay in or Return to Verdigre

The youth were then given a list of reasons and were asked to say if each was a major reason, a minor reason or not a reason they would stay in or return to the Verdigre area. Many youths say the following are major reasons: connections to friends (54.5%), family ties (53%), I grew up here (51%), a good place to raise children (48%), recreational and outdoor activities (43%), quality school (42%), sense of community among residents (40%), I just feel I belong here (40%), and cost of available housing (40%).



Next, students were asked if they would return to the Verdigre area to live in the future if quality career or business ownership opportunities were available. Almost two-thirds said it is likely (44%) or very likely (21%) that they would return to the area in the future. Onequarter were neutral about their future plans to return to the Verdigre area.



When asked what type of jobs/opportunities would encourage them to stay or return to Verdigre to work, the top responses included:

• Agricultural related (14)

Unsure (9)

- trades occupations (6)
- any job (6)
- mechanic (5)
- medical related (5)
- teaching job (4)
- retail business (3)
- hands-on job (3)


Next, they were asked if they would consider buying or starting a business in or around Verdigre

someday. Over one-half (56%) said they would consider buying or starting a business.

The types of businesses they are interested in starting include:

- trade businesses (14)
- food related (7)
- agricultural (5)
- hair salon (3)
- others included: hospital, cosmetics, football card shop, sports card store, childcare,

photography business or interior design, accounting, lawncare, and art related.

The youth were then asked if there are additional lifestyle or job requirements that would be necessary for them to consider staying in or moving back to the Verdigre area. The responses included: none (43), more job opportunities (5), more housing (4), don't know (6), better business opportunities, more moving traffic, more population, family, country lifestyle, more land available to buy, and more places for hands on activities.


# Where Students Like to Learn about Community Information

The youth were asked how they would like to learn about community information in Verdigre. The top choices included: newspaper (60%), school website (51%), community website (51%), Facebook (51%), and community bulletin boards (37%).
